

From Pastor Barbara

In our discussions of the "Blue Zones" video series recently on Sundays, we learned how people like Stamatis lived to be 102 years young, despite a terminal lung cancer diagnosis by 3 different doctors in his 60's. Stamatis didn't start exercising more, didn't start a new drug regimen, but changed his environment. Leaving the US, he moved back to his home island, Ikaria, in Greece, breathed the clean, island air, drank local wine (loaded with antioxidants), had the support of friends, got exercise everyday by tending his vineyard and participated actively in community and his home church.

What needs to change about your environment & life this Lent?

As we studied how people live to be 100 in Blue Zone areas of the world, we realized participating actively in a faith community is part of a long, healthy life (not just being a member, but actively showing up for worship on Sundays, volunteering, helping out, asking us "what can I do to help?").

This Lent at church, we're encouraging you to make & use a God Box, too. A God Box may be made from an empty tissue box, tea box or a box of any kind. Each day during Lent, you write down on paper a prayer that you are giving to God, such as something or someone you're worried about. Write down your worry on paper, fold up the paper, put it in the God Box, and let your worries go!

Let us worship every Sunday and make use of spiritual resources such as the God boxes this Lent. Then let us be open to where the Spirit leads us for our ministry together as FLCCV.


